REACH statement

The European Regulation of 18th December 2006 *concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH)* entered into force on 1st June 2007.

This Regulation rules the use and placing on the European market of certain chemical substances, on their own or contained in preparations or articles, with the aim of identifying their hazardous properties and recommending appropriate risk management measures all along the complete supply chain.
